



# UGC PARAMARSH SCHEME



## Workshop on Soap making






### Faculty Development Programme on Recent Trends and Advancements in Material Research


## Energy Conservation AWARENESS PROGRAMME

## Estrella (Physics Association)





## Faculty Development Program : An Inquiry to Qualitative Research Methodologies




## 'A Start with Startup Mission' - Motivation Session


## Innovative Orientation WORKSHOP




## Media Literacy Club

## Swasthi (Anti-Narcotics Club)


Webinar on Youth and Drug Addiction
