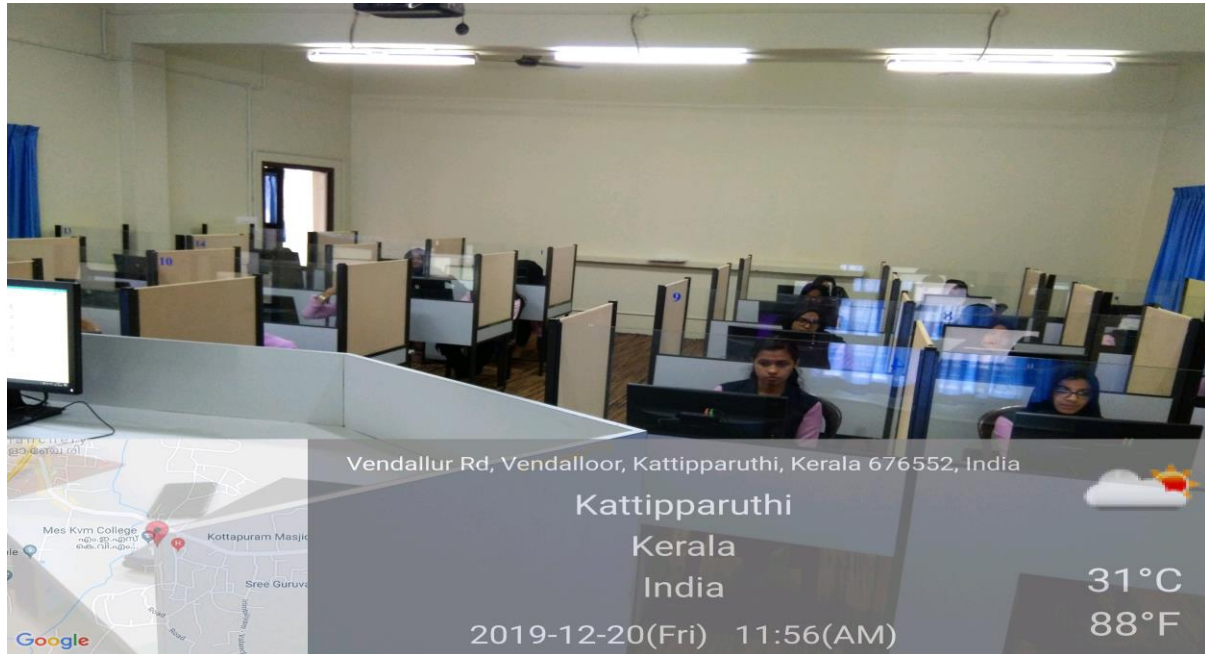


2.3.1 Student Centric Methods

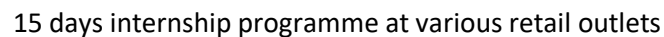

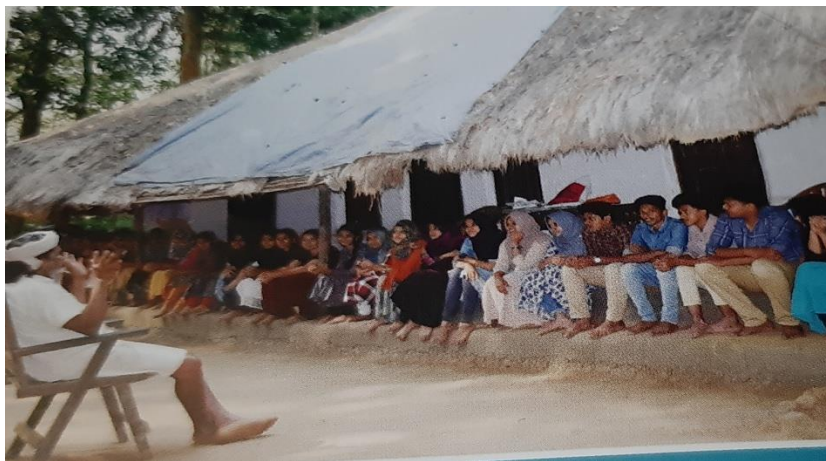

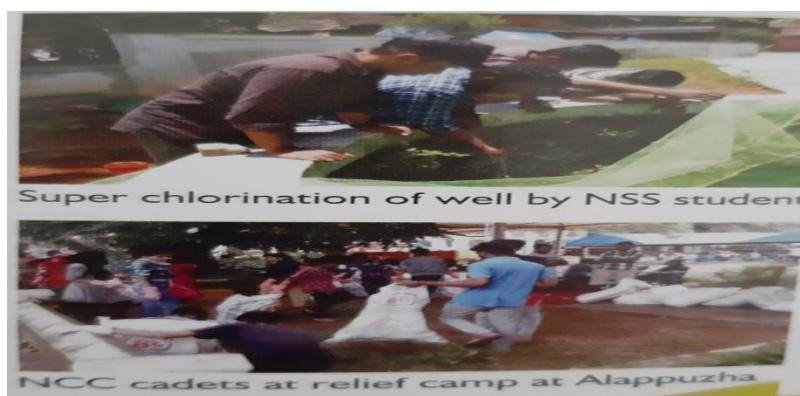

'National Education Day' celebrated and organized a talk on the topic ' Influence of language and culture on education.

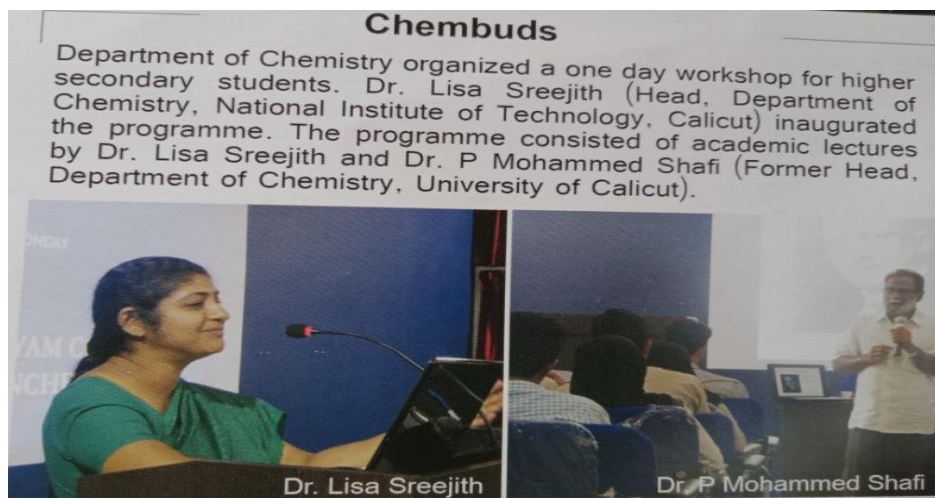



Solace to Destitute: Students visited children's home and interacted with them and celebrated children's day.

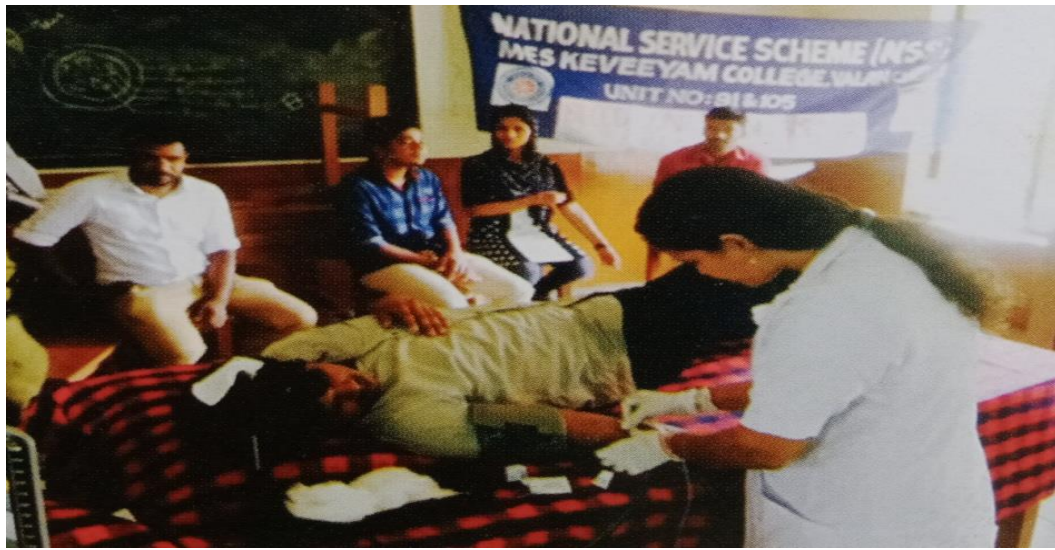
