



# ASAP INDUCTION PROGRAMME FOR FIRST YEARS THE SECOND SPELL




#### SESSION ON WOMEN CYBER SECURITY


MARAKKARA PANCHAYATH.Panchayat president T P Sajna inaugurated the program and The section was led by students of Bachelor of Computer applications.








#### Webinar on Swachhata






# ONE WEEK CERTIFICATE COURSE BY MAHINDRA PRIDE CLASS ROOM (7 TO 12/11/2022)
