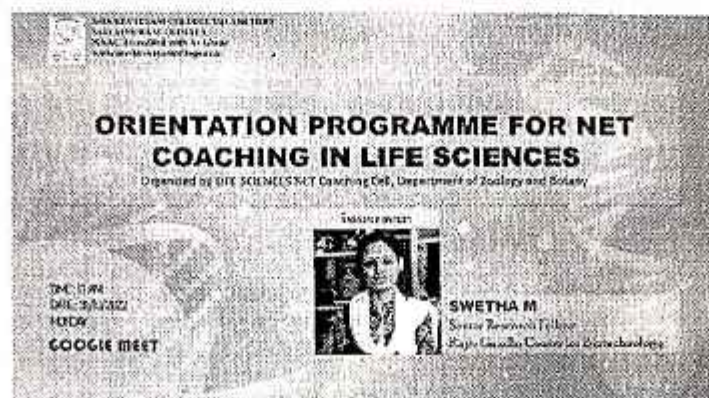


### **AWARENESS TO INTERNSHIP AND PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT (26/09/2022)**

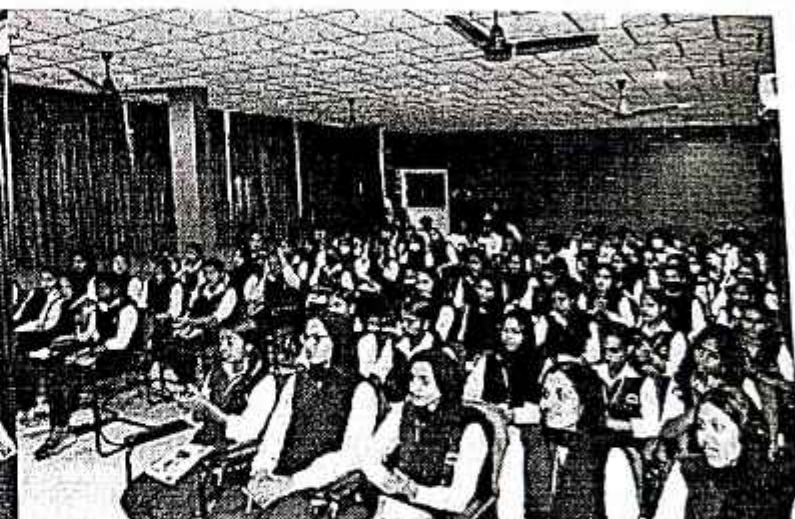
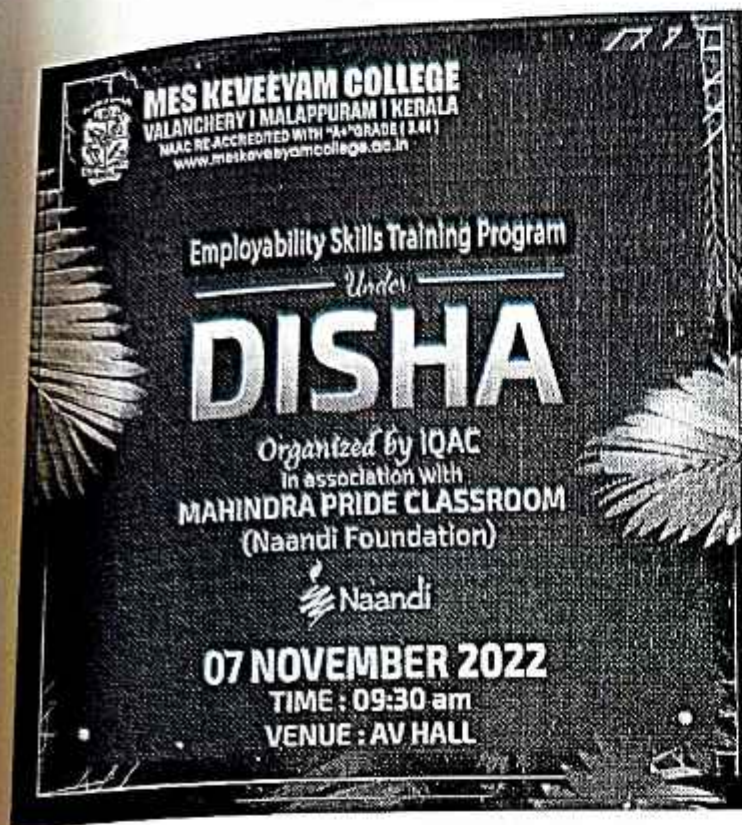




## **1 WEEK CERTIFICATE COURSE BY MAHINDRA PRIDE CLASS ROOM (7 TO 12/ 11/2022)**
