

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at MES Keveeyam College Valanchery organized a one day virtual conference on outcome – based education on 14th September 2022. The conference was intended to formulate a foundational understanding of the emerging changes in the field of education which is now centred on the teaching –learning outcomes. It was an initial step from the part of the institution to have an insight into the new trends and changes occurred in the academic context with the emergence of National Education Policy. The one day virtual conference consisted of three technical sessions and a concluding Q& A session. The programme was inaugurated by Capt. Dr. P Mohamedali, honourable secretary of the institution. Dr. Najla TY, Head of the Department of English and IQAC Coordinator welcomed the gathering. Dr. Habeeb Rahman, Coordinator of Self Financing Courses and Prof. Shibu, Staff Secretary felicitated the programme.

In the valedictory function, participants shared their feedback regarding the conference and representatives of each Department shared their concern over making a sudden shift to the OBE system. Dr.Najla T.Y Head of the Dept of English made a presentation of the Blue print of a Question paper model based on OBE. Dr. C.Rajesh suggested incorporating OBE framework in the upcoming bridge course as an initial step and every other faculty members welcomed the suggestion.
