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

11. KUNG FU TRAINING 21.10.2022




12. JEEVANAM SALES DAY ON 25.10.2022

15. FACE PAINTING COMPETITION 28.11.2022 (Topic:Violence against women)








18. ONLINE SERVICES TRAINING PROGRAM FOR KUDUMBASHREE WORKERS 20/12/2022

23. TRAINING ON INTERVIEW TECHNIQUES ON 17.02.2023










25. PENCIL DRAWING COMPETITION ON 02.03.2023
