An invited talk on “Nurturing the crazy ideas into innovation and IPR”

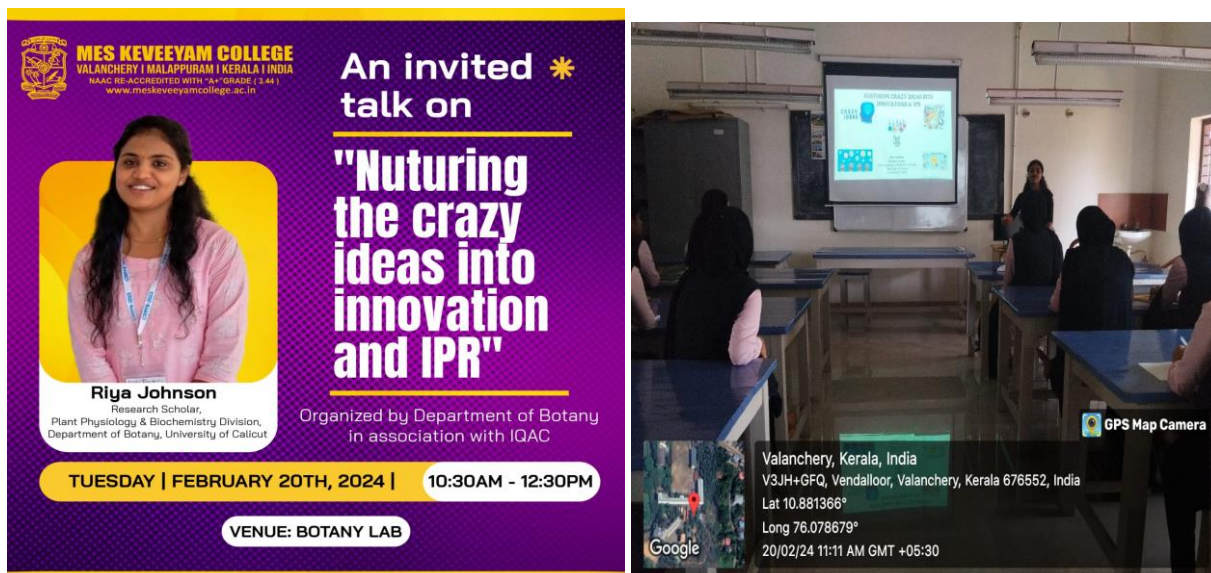

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
Workshop on Insect Taxonomy

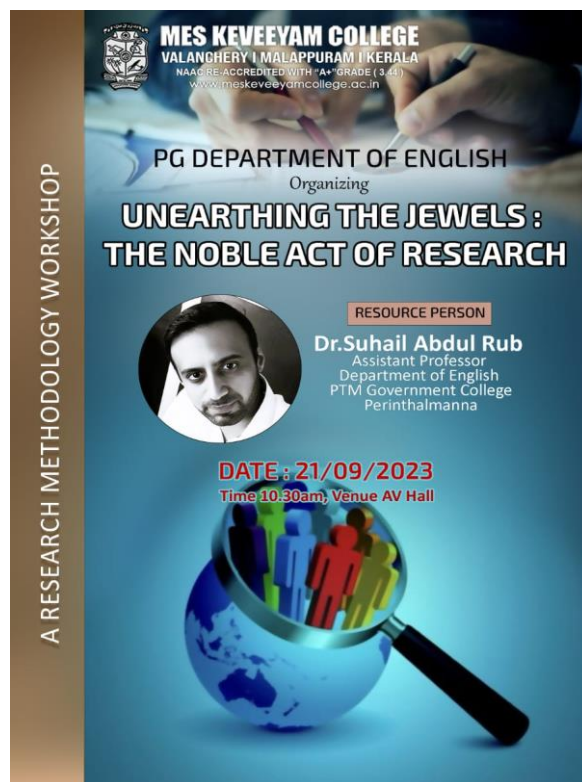

A TALK ON ENGLISH LITERATURE: DISCIPLINE AND BEYOND

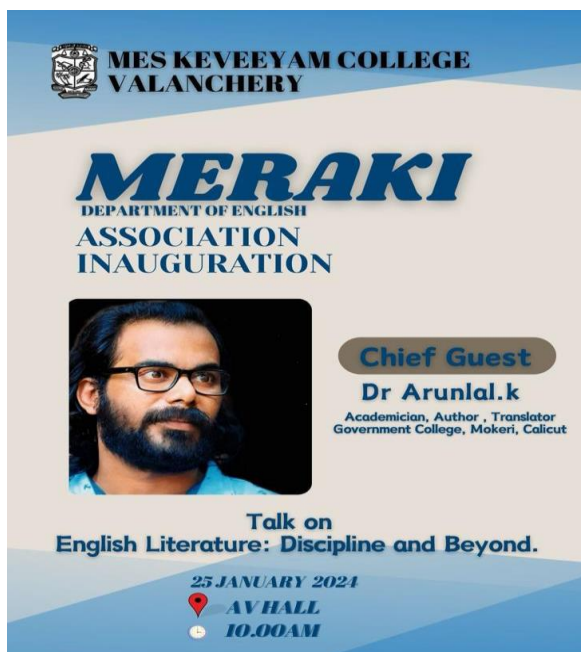
