




Day 1: SWOT Analysis and Resume Building (22/03/2024):


Workshops & Training classes, Seminars, Conferences & Invited talks for Advanced Learners


TALK ON "HOW TO CRACK CSIR- NET IN LIFE SCIENCE"


Workshop on Insect Taxonomy



A TALK ON ENGLISH LITERATURE: DISCIPLINE AND BEYOND











