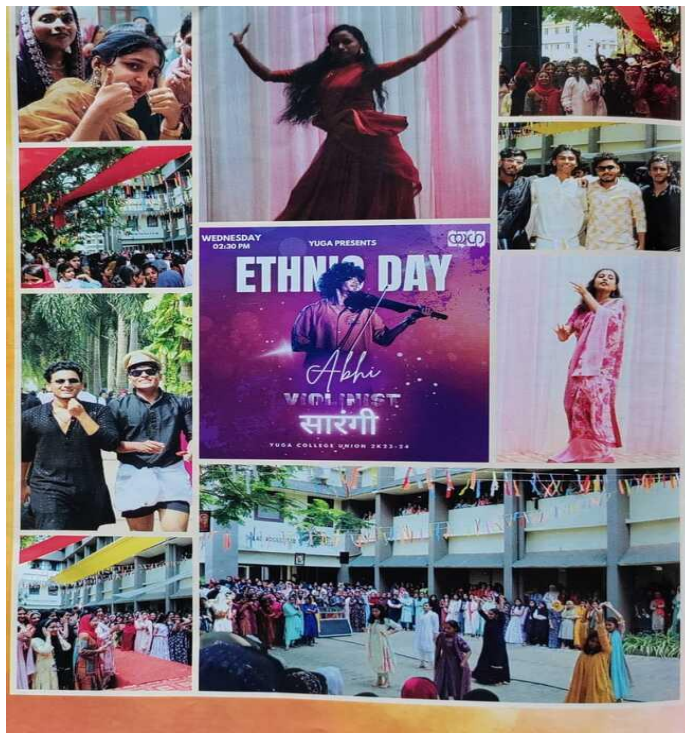
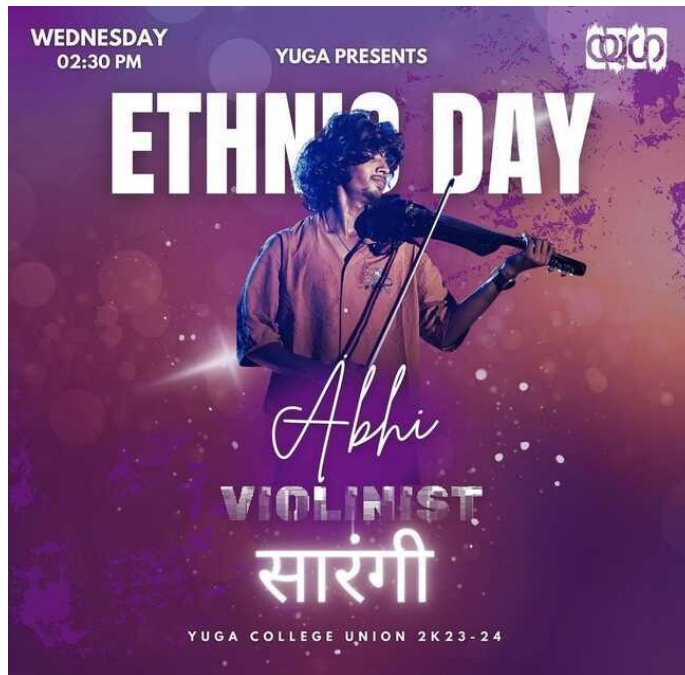
Jingle Gala (Christmas Day Celebration) :

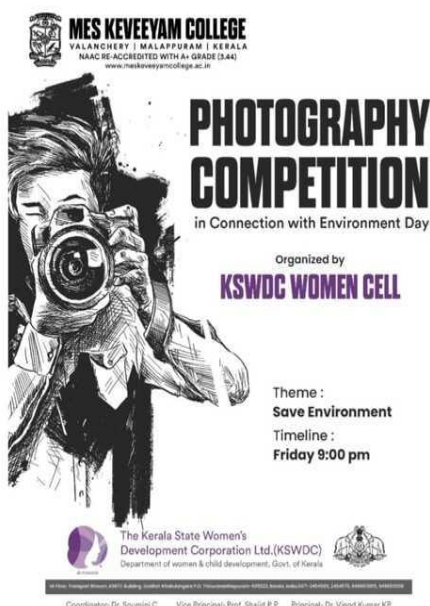

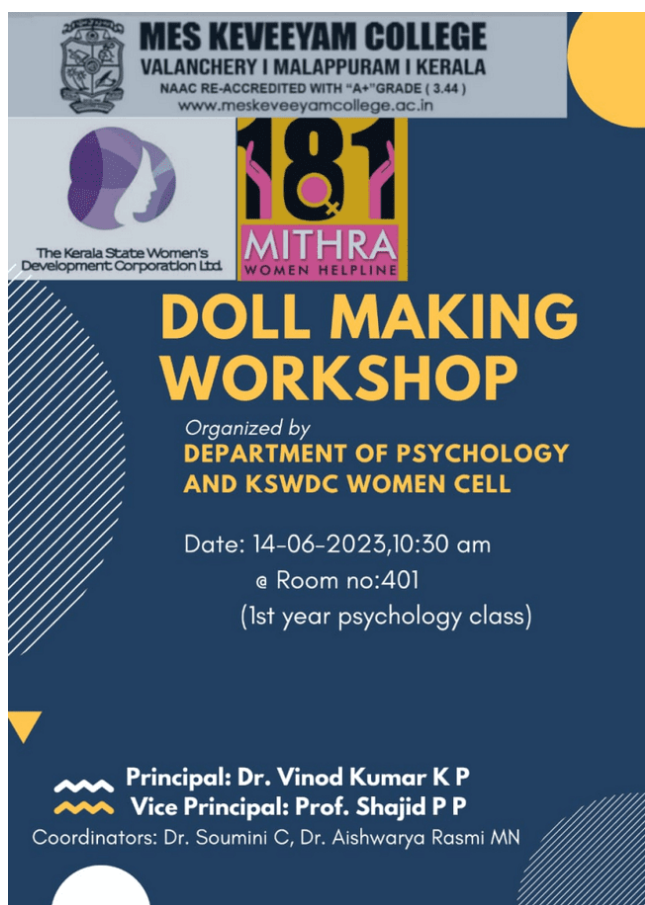

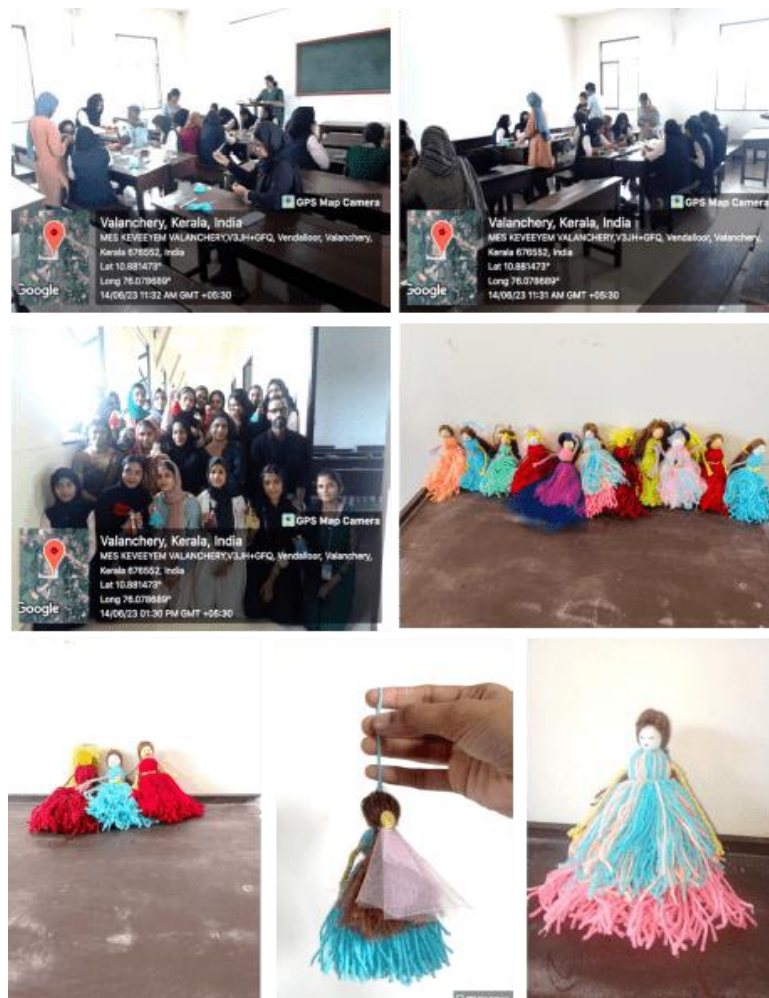
Crafting dreams : Doll making workshop :

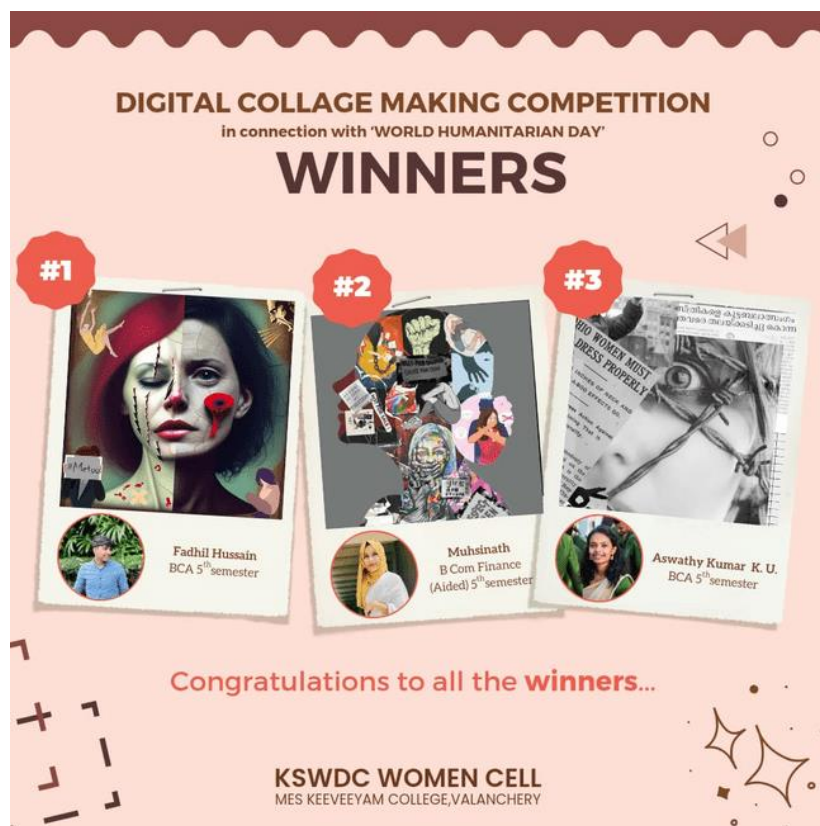

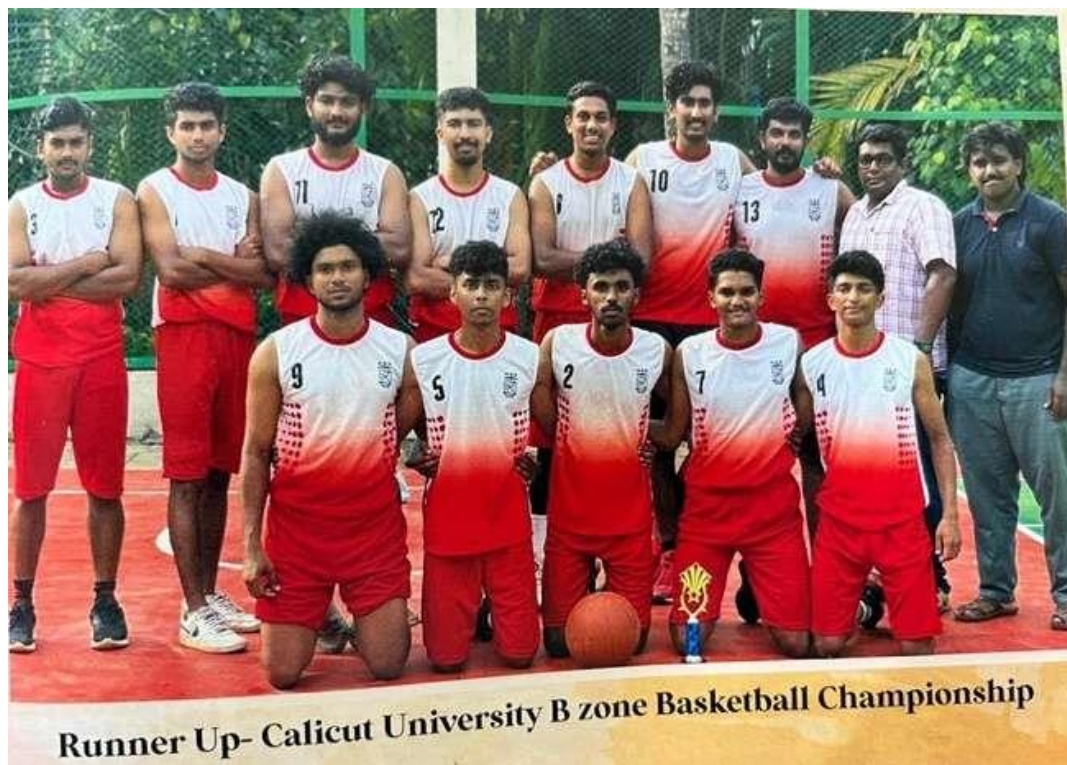

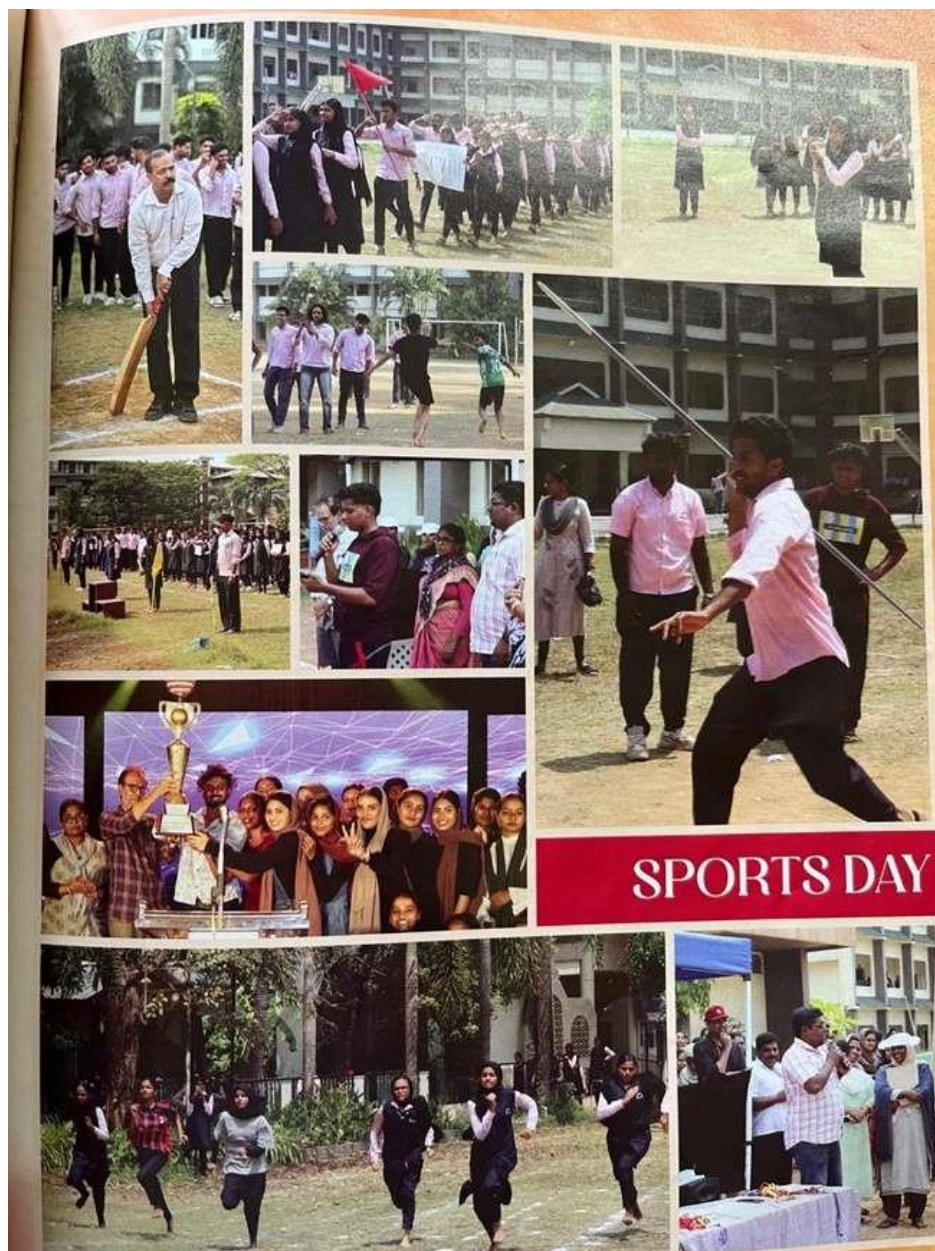
