Admission

Admissions to UG and PG programmes were conducted by Centralised allotment process as per the guidelines of the government and University of Calicut. The total student strength of the institution last year was 922 out of which 679 are girls.

DST-FIST Funded Research Laboratory

Research Laboratory of Chemistry has been set up using the instruments procured using a grant of Rs. 80 lakhs under DST-FIST scheme (Fund for Improvement of Science & Technology infrastructure in universities & higher educational institutions of Department of Science and Technology, Govt. Of India). The Research Laboratory was built using the UGC general development assistance for construction of building (Rs.30 lakhs).
