MES Keveeyam College Ranked 51st in NIRF National Ranking of Colleges

MES Keveeyam College Valanchery has been ranked 51 by National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) of Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India. We are at the 8th position in Kerala. The National Ranking was announced by Union Minister of Human Resource Development Mr. Prakash Javdekar on 3rd April at New Delhi. The ranking was based on the performance of the college in progression of students, employment, university examination results, research, consultancy, projects, extension activities etc.

Inauguration of Research Complex, Commerce Block and Consultancy Division

The Post Graduate Department of Chemistry has been upgraded as a Research Centre under University of Calicut and advanced research and e-learning amenities are installed with the joint funding of FIST programme of Department of Science and Technology, Govt. of India, Universities Grants Commission and the College Management. The state-of-the art Research Complex was inaugurated by Dr. K T Jaleel (Hon. Minister for Local Self Governments, Govt. of Kerala) on 15-04-2017. The PG Department of Commerce moved into a dedicated new block with modern infrastructural features. This block will be inaugurated by Sri. Innocent (Member of Parliament). The Consultancy division, which acts as a facilitator between institution, industry and the larger research community, was launched by Prof. Abid Hussain Tungal MLA.

Formation of Academic Chairs

In a view to promote scholastic studies and hence to uphold the values and disciplines defended by three great visionaries namely Dr. P K Abdul Gafoor, Dr. N K Mohamed and Sri. N Damodaran, Academic Chairs have been constituted in the college by the Managing Committee. The official inauguration of the chairs was done by Dr. K T Jaleel (Hon. Minister for Local Administration) on Friday, 10th February 2017. Prof. Abid Hussain Tungal MLA was the keynote speaker at the function.

National Seminar on ‘Challenges of Kerala Model Education in ensuring Employability among Youth’

In connection with the formation of academic chairs, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organized a National seminar on ‘Challenges of Kerala Model Education in ensuring Employability among Youth’.
