Report

Study in India: Foreign Students Enrolled

The year 2019-20 recorded a milestone in the history for MES Keveeyam College. Foreign students were admitted into the institution for the first time. The enrolment was through the Study in India programme of MHRD, Govt. of India. Mr. Adam Muhammaed (Nigeria), Edmond Boasiako (Ghana), Mizero Heritier (Rwanda) and Nhutinziza Aliance (Rwanda) got admission to MES Keveeyam College through the Study in India programme. MHRD is giving scholarship to two of these students while the institution gives scholarship to the other two.

The college is an active partner of Study in India programme. Dr C Rajesh (Vice Principal) represented college in the annual review meeting of the programme held at New Delhi on 10th February 2020.

Celebration of 150th Birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi

Muslim Educational Society is organizing an yearlong programmes to commemorate the 150th birth anniversary of the father of our nation. As part of this MES Keveeyam College organized different programmes. A seminar on “Mahathma Gandhi and the Concept of India” was organized on 26th November 2019. Dr. K S Madhavan (Department of History, University of Calicut) was the keynote speaker.

As a RUSA funded institution, MHRD has selected our college under the Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat scheme. The programme aims at national integration through cultural and youth exchange among higher education institutions of different states. Our college is paired with Govt.
