Significant Activities and contributions made by IQAC

IQAC contributed the overall developmental and academic activities of the institution. IQAC has encouraged teachers to use digital modes for transaction. Use of facilities of ECDC was promoted. Indigenous learning management system KVM LMS was introduced. Suvidy scholarschip was launched for meritorious students. Programmes for promoting innovations under Institution Innovation Council and IEDC were guided by IQAC. The college participated in NIRF and Atal Ranking for Institutional Innovation Achievements. Internal academic auditing was conducted. IQAC coordinated the activities under the PARAMARSH scheme of UGC for mentoring the non-accredited institutions. Several faculty development programmes were organised under the scheme.

Report

Launching of e-Learning and Virtual Conference Hall

The e-Learning and Virtual Conference Hall was launched on 6th October 2020. The hall was constructed using the FIST (Fund for Improvement of Science & Technology infrastructure in universities & higher educational institutions) of DST (Department of Science and Technology). Dr K T Jaleel (Minister of Higher Education) inaugurated the programme. Dr C Rajesh (Principal) presided over the function. Dr N M Mujeeb Rahman, Mr. Salahuddeen OC (Chairman, College Management Committee), Prof. K P Hassan (Secretary, College Management Committee) and Dr Jisha V S (Coordinator, DST-FIST Implementation) were present on the occasion among others. The Hall is well equipped with facilities for conducting online classes and hosting video conferences in a more convenient and attractive way.

Green Champion Award

The college won the Green Champion Award in 2021. The award was constituted by the Mahatma Gandhi National Council for Rural Education (MGNCRE) under the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India. The award was given to the college based on its achievements in relation to clean and green environment, water conservation, waste management and energy conservation. The college is one among 214 higher education institutions across the country to receive this prestigious award.

Launching of PARAMARSH Scheme

MES Keveeyam College Valanchery has been selected by the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India as one of the mentor institutions under the PARAMARSH scheme of UGC. The scheme is to promote quality initiatives in non-accredited higher educational institutions. Under this scheme our college is the mentor of six colleges. Majlis Arts and Science College Puramannur, Ansar College Valavannur, MES Arts and Science College Perinthalmanna, KR's SN College Thozhuvanur, Markaz Arts and Science College Athavanad and CPA College Puthanathani are the mentee colleges under us. The official inauguration of activities under the PARAMARSH scheme was done by Dr K T Jaleel (Minister of Higher Education) on 3rd August 2020. Separate launching programmes were conducted in mentee colleges. Various programmes including orientation sessions about NAAC accreditation, faculty

development programme, research methodology workshops etc. were conducted in mentee colleges.

3-Star Rating for Institution Innovation Council

The institution innovation council (IIC) of the college has got 3.5 star rating in innovation ranking of Ministry of Education, Govt. of India. The rating was based on the performance in innovating technology, intellectual property rights, entrepreneurship development and start up. College got the fifth position among colleges in Kerala. The IIC of the college has undertaken several activities for promoting innovation and creativity. They have actively participated in hackathons and innovation ambassador training.

Social Entrepreneurship Cell

The college was recognised as a Social Entrepreneurship, Swachhta & Rural Engagement Cell (SES REC) Institution by Mahatma Gandhi National Council for Rural Education under the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India. The Institution has successfully framed the SES REC Action Plan and constituted working groups for improving facilities in the Campus and the adopted villages in the areas of sanitation & hygiene, waste management, water management, energy conservation and greenery.

Skill Training Centre of NSDC

The college was recognised as a skill training centre under National Skill Development Council. The college has an MoU with KELTRON for conducting skill-based value added certificate courses

'Suvidya' Scholarship

The Parent Teacher Association (PTA) launched the Suvidya Scholarship scheme this year. About 100 scholarships are given to meritorious students who do not receive any other government scholarships. A one-week Faculty Development Programme (FDP) in association with the Kerala State Higher Education Council (KSHEC) was conducted by the IQAC of MES Keveeyam College, Valanchery from 3 to 7 August 2020. The FDP on the topic "Pedagogical Approaches and

Participation certificates were distributed to participants who attended all the sessions.

Preparation and Submission of Covid Survey Report
